In-Service on the National Pastoral Plan for Hispanic/Latino Ministry

Fundraising Kit

In-Service Fundraising Ideas

Here are 13 ways Catholic parishes, dioceses, and organizations can fundraise to cover the costs of a 1-day In-Service event.

- 1. It is recommended that Diocesan Directors add the Diocesan In-Service as a budget item for the corresponding fiscal year.
- 2. Seek donations from local businesses or community members.
 - a) Ask a local restaurant or supermarket to donate food in exchange for a tax write-off document, free ad, or recognition in a bulletin or newsletter. See sample letter below.
 - b) Request a local retailer or office supplies store donate notepads and pens for the event as a tax write-off. See sample letter below.
 - c) Request local retailers to donate gift cards so that you can purchase any supplies needed for your event or to raffle as a fundraiser. See sample letter below.
 - d) Request a donation from a local casino or business. See sample letter below.
- 3. Seek sponsorship funding from local Catholic organizations or institutions in exchange for allowing them to exhibit at your event and additional advertising opportunities.
- 4. Charge for exhibiting at your event. Create a package for exhibitors that includes prime booth locations and additional advertising opportunities.
- 5. Host a fundraising dinner or luncheon.
- 6. Seek sponsorship from various ministry groups in the parish/organization/diocese.
- 7. Request donations from parishioners during Mass one Sunday.
- 8. Partner with local restaurants for a dine-out night, where a percentage of sales go towards the event. Market the event to parishioners or members of your organization.
- 9. Create and sell custom merchandise, such as t-shirts or mugs.
- 10. Sell V Encuentro/Eucharistic Revival crosses and V Encuentro Pocket Gospels. They can be sent to you upon request. Contact Alejandro Aguilera-Titus aaguilera-titus@usccb.org.
- 11. Offer a car wash service in exchange for donations.
- 12. Host a bake sale or breakfast/dinner at the parish or organization/institution.
- 13. Hold a raffle with donated prizes.

These fundraising activities can help generate funds to cover the costs of facilitators, food, supplies, rental space, and liturgists for the event.

Donation Letters

Check with your parish/diocesan/organization development director or business manager to see if you already have templates for this and to ensure that they have not already requested funds from the business/organization. You could also provide the following templates and allow them to edit them accordingly. Make sure to use the parish, diocesan or organization's letterhead. Check the organization/business website to see if they have any limitations for donations since some businesses and organizations do not support religious institutions.
